TML Workshop Tuition Scholarships for Small Cities

The TML Small Cities Advisory Council set up a workshop tuition scholarship program for small cities in 2010. At selected workshops, TML awards a complimentary workshop registration and up to \$100 in travel-related expenses. At most workshops, three scholarships are awarded. For the TML Annual Conference and Exhibition, TML will award up to ten scholarships with each recipient receiving a complimentary registration and reimbursement up to \$500 in travel-related expenses. Funding for the TML Annual Conference and Exhibition scholarships is provided by enhanced sponsorship revenue.

An applicant must be a city official in a TML member city with less than 15,000 in population. A city official cannot be awarded more than one tuition scholarship per calendar year, and scholarships are non-transferable.

Scholarship winners are randomly selected and notified in advance of the workshop. To apply for a scholarship, go to www.tml.org and click on "Small Cities" under the "Resources" tab. Then click on the "TML Training Scholarships for Small Cities" link.

Since November 2023 the scholarship program has saved city officials a total of \$2,565 in registrations and up to \$1,700 in travel reimbursements.
