

## **TML Workshop Tuition Scholarships for Small Cities**

The TML Small Cities Advisory Council created a tuition scholarship program in 2010 for city officials from member cities under 15,000 in population. At selected workshops, TML awards complimentary registration and up to \$100 in travel expenses (typically three per workshop). For the TML Annual Conference and Exhibition, up to ten scholarships are awarded with travel reimbursement of up to \$500, funded by enhanced sponsorship revenue.

Each official may receive only one scholarship per calendar year, and awards are non-transferable. Recipients are selected at random and notified in advance. To apply, visit [www.tml.org](http://www.tml.org), click Resources → Small Cities → TML Training Scholarships for Small Cities.

***Since November 2025, the scholarship program has saved city officials a total of \$1,110 in registrations and up to \$600\* in travel reimbursements.***
